Partnerships:

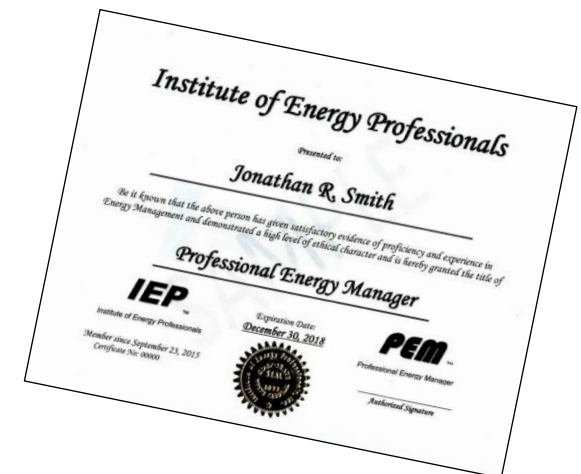
Recognizing the ever-increasing need for qualified energy professionals, IEP has participated with multiple universities known for their engineering programs and partnered with NC State University and Schneider-Electric's successful on-line *Energy University*. Through these venues we are able to expand energy training initiatives. \

Professional Certification:

Beginning in 2009 IEP offered the *Professional Energy Manager (PEM)* Certification to those that completed

the three-week training program and achieved a passing score on a comprehensive written examination. This certification recognizes that the participant has attained an understanding of the fundamental principles and strategies required for the development of an effective and sustainable energy management program.

The certification has received widespread recognition, with PEM in key decision-making positions in the USA and in more than thirty (30) countries.



Who Should Attend Training?

Anyone with accountability for, or interest in, energy programs would benefit from this training. The program is designed for all levels of involvement, from the CEO, plant engineer, energy manager or maintenance personnel.

Other IEP Services:

Training – In addition to the comprehensive three-week training program, IEP offers single and multiple day training initiatives focused on specific end use equipment and systems, such as HVAC, chillers and cooling towers, lighting, compressed air systems, and others. These programs can be tailored to customer equipment and performed in-house.

Technical Services – The *Institute* also provides a variety technical services to clients including energy assessments specifically structured around three (3) primary objectives:

- To evaluate the major energy consuming systems and identify opportunities to improve performance and/or reduce operating costs,
- To upgrade the energy expertise of site personnel, and
- To identify *Best Operating Practices*



IEP assessments are unique in that in addition to identifying savings opportunities, they are used as educational tools. Site personnel are encouraged to participate. They are provided instruction in the evaluation

and optimization of system performance, so that information can be passed along to others, thereby increasing the overall knowledge base and assuring sustained efficient operation.
